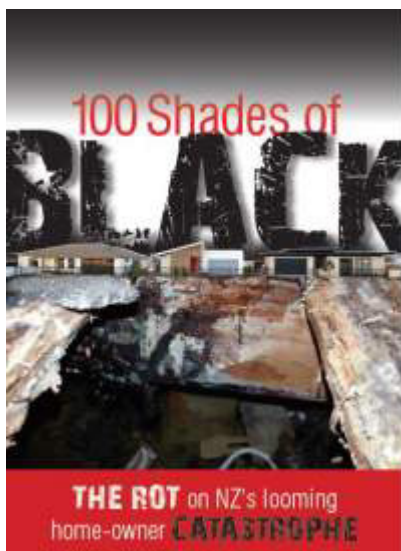


### *"A week in DANA conference programming"*
